Yellow Rose Scholarship

SCHOLARSHIP DESCRIPTION

The purpose of the Zonta Club of Annapolis *Yellow Rose Scholarship* is to provide financial assistance to a woman who had suspended her formal education and now is returning to school. The goal of the Scholarship is to assist women in obtaining additional knowledge and skills which will lead to additional workplace opportunities/advancement, greater lifetime financial security for themselves and their families, increased personal satisfaction, and greater civic involvement. The *Yellow Rose Scholarship* award for 2025-2026 is \$1,500.

ELIGIBILITY

An applicant must be a woman

- ✓ residing in Anne Arundel County, Maryland who is 25 years old as of June 30, 2025 (born on or before June 30, 2000),
- ✓ who will be enrolled, full-time or part-time, at an accredited university/college/institute/trade/certificate program at the time the scholarship is awarded, and
- ✓ who was not enrolled in or attended an accredited university/college/institute/trade/certificate program at any time from June 1, 2023 through May 31, 2025 (inclusive).

In addition, an applicant must

- ✓ submit a fully completed application no later than May 31, 2025. Applications must be typed. The application is a fillable pdf.

Relatives of Zonta Club of Annapolis members and their spouses/cohabitating partners are not eligible. Relatives include ancestors, descendants, siblings, nieces, or cousins and those of their spouse/cohabitating partner.

APPLICATION PROCESS

The application process is described below. Send questions via e-mail to president@zontaclubannapolis.org.

- ✓ Applicants must submit applications by the May 31, 2025 deadline. Applications submitted via e-mail should be sent to president@zontaclubannapolis.org and must be date stamped no later than May 31, 2025. Applicants who want to submit an application via the US Postal Service must e-mail president@zontaclubannapolis.org to obtain the mailing address. Applications submitted on paper must be postmarked no later than May 31, 2025. In addition, if you submit by paper, please send an e-mail to president@zontaclubannapolis.org to notify us that you have sent a paper application.
- ✓ Members of the Zonta Club of Annapolis Scholarship Committee will review and evaluate the applications and select one applicant to receive the scholarship. The selectee will be chosen by July 15, 2025.
- ✓ The selectee will be notified via e-mail. To finalize the *Yellow Rose Scholarship*, the Zonta Club of Annapolis will provide the selectee with a verification of enrollment form. To be awarded the *Yellow Rose Scholarship*, the selectee must have the educational institution complete and officially stamp the form and return it to the Zonta Club of Annapolis by the date set by the Club.
- ✓ The *Yellow Rose Scholarship* award will be paid to the educational institution.
- ✓ All applicants will be notified of the outcome of the selection process via e-mail.


